


- The Fall 2023 unduplicated enrollment of 2,196 students represents an increase of 317 students, or 16.8%, over the Fall 2022 enrollment of 1,879 students. It is 28.1% higher than the Spring 2023 enrollment of 1,714 students.
- 61% of students are commuters.
  Approximately 847 (39%) live on campus.
- 53% or 1,161 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (329), Sunflower (192), Washington (162), Holmes (148), followed by Bolivar (92) and Coahoma (70).
- 27% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from TN (192), LA (85), TX (65), and GA (44). There are 18 international students.
   France and Nigeria each have four (4) students.

## **FALL 2023 ENROLLMENT PROFILE**

- 9% of students are Other-Race, including 105 White students.
- There are 635 new students (561 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers, Non-Formula Students) and (74 graduates) who represent 29% of total enrollment.
