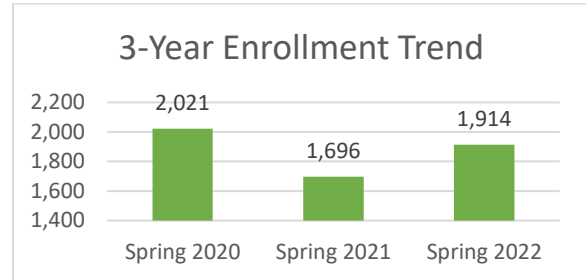




SPRING 2022 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Spring 2022 unduplicated **enrollment of 1,914** students represents a decrease of 150 students, or -7.27%, over the Fall 2021 enrollment of 2,064 students. It is a 12.85% increase from the Spring 2021 enrollment of 1,696 students.
- **69%** of students are **commuters**. Approximately 601 live on campus.
- **53%** or 1,011 students are from surrounding **Delta counties**. Most are from Leflore (301), Washington (183), Holmes, (144) and Sunflower (107) counties.
- **22%** of students are from **out-of-state**. Most are from Tennessee (84), Texas (50), Georgia (41) and Illinois (39)
- There are **24 international** students, most are from Nigeria.
- **13%** of students are **Other-Race**, including **173 White and 47 Hispanic** students.
- There are **65 new students** (53 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers and 12 graduates) who represent 3% of total enrollment.
