

The Valley@GHEC Degree Completion Program is designed to teach students in an accessible format so they can earn the credits they need to complete a bachelor's degree in just two years. Graduates are well-prepared to work in professional fields, serve in social services or education, or pursue graduate education. They are equipped with the skills and abilities necessary to succeed in all areas of life.

Students with an associate's degree are eligible to enter the Valley@GHEC Degree Completion Program and may choose from any of the following career paths:

HEALTH, PHYSICAL EDUCATION, AND RECREATION

The Health, Physical Education, and Recreation Program offers two degree options. A teaching concentration is offered for individuals interested in obtaining a license to teach at the K-12 levels and a non-teaching concentration is offered for individuals interested in careers in federal, state, and local parks and recreation agencies; commercial recreation agencies; campus recreation; military recreation; and voluntary community agencies.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE

The Criminal Justice Program prepares students for employment in County jails, State and Federal correctional facilities. Additionally, graduates find work with law firms, state and federal law enforcement agencies and Private security companies.

SPEECH AND COMMUNICATION

The degree program in Speech and Communications enables undergraduate students to become effective communicators with the capability of working effectively in a multicultural, multi-disciplinary, and multiracial society.

MASS COMMUNICATION

The degree program in Mass Communications prepares students for careers in the media industry, and other related communication fields through its curricular offerings in the areas of broadcasting, journalism and public relations. Upon graduation, students will be ready to assume effective roles in professional communication careers or proceed to graduate school for advanced degrees.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE

The Master of Science in Criminal Justice prepares graduate students for entry/ supervisory level positions in the criminal justice field, including preparation for doctoral studies.
