

- FALL 2015 ENROLLMENT PROFILE
- The Fall 2015 unduplicated enrollment of 2,309 students represents an increase of 87 students, or 3.9%, over the Fall 2014 enrollment of 2,222 students. It is 7.4% higher than the Spring 2015 enrollment of 2,138 students.
- 60% of students are commuters.
 Approximately 932 live on campus.
- 66% of students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (546), Washington (237), Sunflower (178), Bolivar (116), and Humphreys (114) counties.
- 22% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (119), Illinois (77), and Georgia (59). There are 34 international

- students, most of whom are from Kazakhstan.
- 4% of students are Other-Race, including 61 White students.
- There are 658 new students (537 undergraduate and 121 graduate) who represent 29% of total enrollment.
