


- The Fall 2016 unduplicated enrollment of 2,455 students represents an increase of 146 students, or 6%, over the Fall 2015 enrollment of 2309 students. It is 16% higher than the Spring 2016 enrollment of 2,114 students.
- 61% of students are commuters.
 Approximately 949 live on campus.
- 68% of students are from surrounding Delta counties, mostly Leflore (597), Washington (220), Sunflower (195), Humphreys (152) and Coahoma (135).
- 22% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (121), Illinois (71), and Georgia (61). There are 31 international students, most from Kazakhstan.

FALL 2016 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- 4% of students are Other-Race, including 68 White students.
- There are 814 new students (583 undergraduate and 231 graduate) who represent 33% of total enrollment.
