Spring 2009 Enrollment Profile

- The Spring 2009 enrollment of 2,715 students is a decrease of 214 students (-7%) from Fall 2008. The unduplicated Spring 2008 enrollment was 2,911.
- Females make up 66% of total enrollment, 63% of undergraduate enrollment, and 82% of graduate enrollment.
- A majority of MVSU students (1,959 or 72%) are from the following surrounding Delta counties: Leflore (826), Washington (372), Sunflower (303), Bolivar (159), Coahoma (106), Humphreys (101), and Holmes (92).
- 12% of undergraduates are part-time students while 78% of graduate students are part-time. Overall, part-time students (596) comprise 22% of the total enrollment.
- There are 57 entering freshmen compared to 42 entering freshmen in Spring 2008.
- The average ACT composite for entering freshmen is 17.8. This is compared to an average of 17.3 in Fall 2008 and 16.6 in Spring 2008.
- The raw number of non-resident students is 320 compared to 365 in Fall 2008. Most out-of-state students are from Illinois (59), Tennessee (8) and Texas (32), followed by Georgia (30) and Arkansas (24).
- White students make up 3% of the total enrollment. The number of White students has decreased by 24 since Spring 2008.
- There are 111 new undergraduate students. This includes new freshmen, transfers, and Non-formula students 21 and older. Also, there are 44 new graduate students. Altogether, new students (155) represent 6% of total enrollment.
- International enrollment is 19 and includes mostly students from Canada and Russia.
- The most popular undergraduate majors, in order of enrollment, are Business Administration (25), Social Work (240), Elementary Education (225), HPER (194) and Early Childhood Education (193).
