## Mississippi Valley State University Spring 2012 Enrollment Profile

- The Spring 2012 enrollment of 2,324 students decreased by 128 students (5%) from Fall 2011. It represents an 8% decrease from Spring 2011 enrollment of 2,524.
- Females make up 63% of total enrollment, 61% undergraduate enrollment, and 75% of the graduate enrollment.
- Sixty-five percent or (1,518) of students are commuters. Approximately 806 students reside in campus housing.
- 1,849 of our currently enrolled students (80%) are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (699), Washington (283), Sunflower (223), Bolivar (120), and Holmes (111).
- Eighteen percent of undergraduates are parttime students while 61% of graduate students are part-time. Overall, the student body is comprised of 577 or 25% part-time students.
- There are 36 First-Time Freshmen (FTF) compared to 4352 entering freshmen in Spring 2011.
- The average ACT composite for entering freshmen is 17.0. This is compared to an average of 17.2 in Fall 2010 and 17.7 in Spring 2011.
- The raw number of out-of-state students is 253. The percentage of enrollment out-of-state students is 11%. Most of these students are from Tennessee (43), Illinois

- (510, and Texas (22) followed by California and Georgia (21).
- White students make up 3% of the total enrollment. The number of White students decreased from Fall 2011. It now stands at 79.
- There are 85 new undergraduates students.
   This includes new freshmen, transfers, and Non-formula students 21 and older. Also, there are 16 new graduate students.
   Altogether, new students represent 4% of the total enrollment.
- Enrollment for International students stands at 27. The majority are from Canada (15) followed by Nigeria (5).
- The most popular undergraduate majors are Social Work (229), Business Administration (218), HPER (200), Early Childhood Education (173), and Biology (170) followed by Criminal Justice (159) and Elementary Education (138). The most popular graduate majors are Criminal Justice (106), Social Work (91), and MAT (53).
