

Mississippi Valley State University
Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund- Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students
Report as of May 21, 2020

Mississippi Valley State University (MVSU) acknowledges that it signed and returned the Recipient's Funding Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. MVSU intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Mississippi Valley State University received \$1,539,915 in Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) – Student Aid

As of May 21, 2020, MVSU has not distributed any Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 1804 (a)(1).

MVSU estimates that 1,825 of its students are eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended (HEA) and are eligible to receive an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

As of May 21, 2020, MVSU students have not received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

MVSU used the Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) from students' 2019 FAFSA submission to determine award amounts concentrating on students with the greatest need. Award amounts are \$500 and \$750 per student depending on the EFC range. EFC ranges are between 0 to 5576 and 5577 to 9999.

Students were provided with instructions and guidance through several announcements through email, text messages and various social media outlets.
