

- The Fall 2018 unduplicated enrollment of 2,285 students represents a decrease of 100 students, or -4.0%, over the Fall 2017 enrollment of 2,385 students. It is 7% higher than the Spring 2018 enrollment of 2,142 students.
- 59% of students are commuters.
   Approximately 941 live on campus.
- 65% or 1,493 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (499), Washington (226), Sunflower (183), Humphreys (136) and Coahoma (119) counties.
- 23% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (124) and Illinois (87), followed by Georgia (52) and Texas with (51). There are 26 international students, most are from Nigeria.

## **FALL 2018 ENROLLMENT PROFILE**

- 4% of students are Other-Race, including 46 White students.
- There are 654 new students (557 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers, Non-Formula Students) and 97 graduates) who represent 29% of total enrollment.
