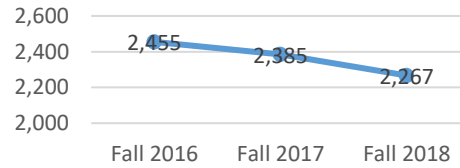




## FALL 2018 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Fall 2018 unduplicated **enrollment** of **2,267** students represents a decrease of 118 students, or -5.0%, over the Fall 2017 enrollment of 2,385 students. It is 6% higher than the Spring 2018 enrollment of 2,142 students.
- **59%** of students are **commuters**. Approximately 936 live on campus.
- **65%** or 1,478 students are from surrounding **Delta counties**. Most are from Leflore (496), Washington (225), Sunflower (181), Humphreys (136) and Coahoma (117) counties.
- **23%** of students are from **out-of-state**. Most are from Tennessee (145) and Illinois (87), followed by Georgia and Texas with (51). There are **27 international** students, most are from Nigeria.
- **4%** of students are **Other-Race**, including **45 White** students.
- There are **652 new students** (556 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers, Non-Formula Students) and 96 graduates) who represent 29% of total enrollment.
