Master of Science in Environmental Health (MSEH) program is transitioning to online at Mississippi Valley State University. We are currently reviewing Fall 2020 applications for the graduate Environmental Health program. The extended deadline for submitting the application is **July 15, 2020**. For a limited time, the program will waive the GRE test requirement. The MSEH program duration is approximately two years, and it is transitioning to an online format with planned full-time coursework (9-10 credit hours) available online for each semester (Fall 2020 and Spring 2021), and full transition to online for Fall 2021. The program is also fully accredited by the National Environmental Health Science and Protection Accreditation Council (EHAC).
