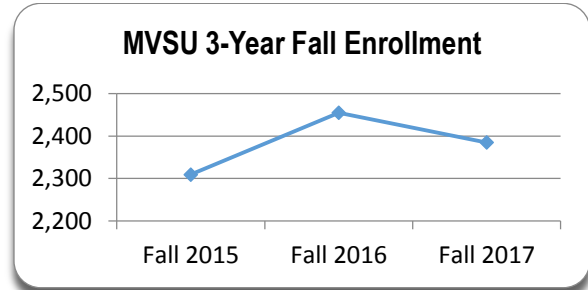




## FALL 2017 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Fall 2017 unduplicated **enrollment of 2,385** students represents a decrease of 70 students, or -3.0%, over the Fall 2016 enrollment of 2,455 students. It is 6% higher than the Spring 2017 enrollment of 2,258 students.
- **60%** of students are **commuters**. Approximately 945 live on campus.
- **65%** or 1,561 students are from surrounding **Delta counties**. Most are from Leflore (562), Washington (214), Sunflower (196), Humphreys (115) and Coahoma (112) counties.
- **22%** of students are from **out-of-state**. Most are from Tennessee (143), Illinois (74), and Georgia (55). There are **32 international** students, most are from Kazakhstan.
- **4%** of students are **Other-Race**, including **50 White** students.
- There are **715 new students** (610 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers, Non-Formula Students) and 105 graduates) who represent 30% of total enrollment.
