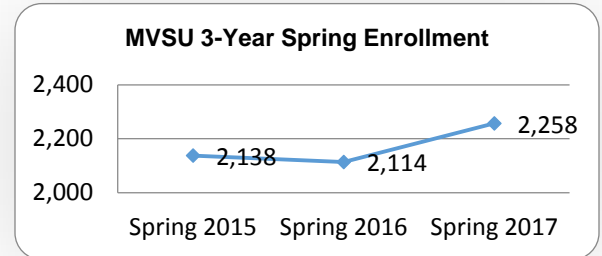




- The Spring 2017 unduplicated **enrollment of 2,258** students represents a decrease of 197 students, or -8.0% from Fall 2016. It is 6.8% higher than the Spring 2016 enrollment of 2,114 students.
- **65%** of students are **commuters**. Approximately 793 live on campus.
- **69%** of students are from **surrounding Delta counties**. Most are from Leflore (545), Washington (225), Sunflower (169), Humphreys (140), and Bolivar (97) counties.
- **20%** of students are from **out-of-state**. Most are from Tennessee (119), Illinois (59), and Georgia (52). There are 19 **international** students, most of who are from Kazakhstan.
- **4%** of students are **Other-Race**, including **55 White** students.
- There are 106 **new students** (58 undergraduate and 48 graduates) who represent 5% of total enrollment.
