


SPRING 2017 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Spring 2017 unduplicated enrollment of 2,258 students represents a decrease of 197 students, or -8.0% from Fall 2016. It is 6.8% higher than the Spring 2016 enrollment of 2,114 students.
- 65% of students are commuters.
 Approximately 793 live on campus.
- 69% of students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (545), Washington (225), Sunflower (169), Humphreys (140), and Bolivar (97) counties.
- 20% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (119), Illinois (59), and Georgia (52). There are 19 international students, most of who are from Kazakhstan.
- 4% of students are Other-Race, including 55
 White students.

 There are 106 new students (58 undergraduate and 48 graduates) who represent 5% of total enrollment.
