


- The Spring 2018 unduplicated enrollment of 2,142 students represents a decrease of 243 students, or -10.0%, over the Fall 2017 enrollment of 2,385 students. It is a -5% decrease from the Spring 2017 enrollment of 2,258 students.
- 61% of students are commuters.
 Approximately 839 live on campus.
- 66% or 1,407 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (502), Washington (192), Sunflower (172), Humphreys (122) and Coahoma (99) counties.
- 22% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (124), Illinois (67), Texas (49) and Georgia (44). There are 25 international students, most are from Kazakhstan.

SPRING 2018 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- 4% of students are Other-Race, including 51 White students.
- There are 85 new students (59 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen and New Transfers) and 26 graduates) who represent 4% of total enrollment.
