

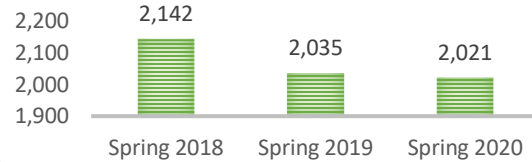


SPRING 2020 ENROLLMENT PROFILE

- The Spring 2020 unduplicated enrollment of **2,021** students represents a decrease of 126 students, or -5.9%, over the Fall 2019 enrollment of 2,147 students. It is a -.68% decrease from the Spring 2019 enrollment of 2,035 students.
- 62%** of students are **commuters**. Approximately 768 live on campus.
- 67%** or 1,349 students are from surrounding **Delta counties**. Most are from Leflore (458), Washington (281), Sunflower (195), and Humphreys (106) counties.
- 22%** of students are from **out-of-state**. Most are from Tennessee (108), Illinois (61), Georgia (50) and Texas (37). There are **31 international** students, most are from Nigeria.

- 4%** of students are **Other-Race**, including **36 White** students.
- There are 108 **new students** (72 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers and 36 graduates) who represent 5% of total enrollment.
