

- The Spring 2021 unduplicated enrollment of 1,696 students represents a decrease of 336 students, or -16.5%, over the Fall 2020 enrollment of 2,032 students. It is a -16.1% decrease from the Spring 2020 enrollment of 2,021 students.
- 70% of students are commuters.
 Approximately 517 live on campus.
- 63% or 1,071 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (323), Washington (205), Sunflower (151), and Humphreys (87) counties.
- 24% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (80), Illinois (49), Texas (45) and Georgia (33).
- There are 27 international students, most are from Nigeria.

- 4% of students are Other-Race, including 23
 White and 25 Hispanic students.
- There are 134 new students (72 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen, New Transfers and 62 graduates) who represent 8% of total enrollment.
