

MISSISSIPPI VALLEY STATE

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- The Spring 2023 unduplicated enrollment of 1,714 students represents a decrease of 165 students, or -9%, from the Fall 2022 enrollment of 1,879 students. It is a -10% decrease from the Spring 2022 enrollment of 1,914 students.
- 66% of students are commuters. Approximately 549 students live on campus.
- 54% or 928 students are from surrounding Delta counties. Most are from Leflore (264), Holmes, (137), Washington (124) and Sunflower (116) counties.
- 21% of students are from out-of-state. Most are from Tennessee (81), Texas (48), Georgia (44) and Illinois (31)
- There are **17** international students, most are from Nigeria.

- 12% of students are Other-Race, including
 152 White and 52 Hispanic students.
- There are 105 new students. 79 are undergraduates (First-time freshmen & New Transfers) and 26 are graduates. They represent 6% of total enrollment.
