

Of the 15 public and private higher education institutions in the state of Mississippi, thirteen submitted data to establish the external benchmarks for a statewide EPP Impact Report. The participating EPPs are noted on the map below.

Thirteen institutions of higher learning that comprise the Mississippi Education Preparation Providers (EPP) requested that the Statewide Longitudinal Data System (SLDS) provide information required for national accreditation through CAEP. These 13 institutions are Alcorn State University, Belhaven University, Blue Mountain Christian University, Delta State University, Jackson State University, Mississippi College, Mississippi State University, Mississippi University for Women, Mississippi Valley State University, Rust College, The University of Mississippi, The University of Southern Mississippi, and William Carey University.

Each of the 13 institutions provided the SLDS Clearinghouse with supplemental data containing information on teacher education program completers, including certification track (traditional vs. alternate route), licensure exam results, Teacher Intern Assessment Instrument (TIAI) and Disposition scores, as well as admission information. The data were used in conjunction with de-identified data already in the SLDS Clearinghouse to produce reports to assist with CAEP annual reporting measures. SLDS data are not reported if numeric values are less than 10. This excludes data reported by the MS Department of Education.

A cohort design was used where individuals graduating from each of the EPPs in a given academic year were followed over time to identify their subsequent performance outcomes. Reports containing the results were produced for each participating EPP as well as a statewide report which is contained in this Mississippi Impact Report Card. The statewide Educator Preparation Provider Collaborative Committee (EPPCC) designated a subcommittee to develop the format and methodology of the Mississippi Impact Report Card led by Dr. Mitzy Johnson (retired) and Mrs. Jenny Hartness (Mississippi State University), Dr. Ann Monroe and Dr. Sara Platt (University of Mississippi), and Dr. Yanbing Tang and Mr. Leslie Charlton (National Strategic Planning and Analysis Research Center (NSPARC)).

Interpretation of the Data:

The data reported are drawn from the *2025 Mississippi Impact Report Card for Teacher Education Programs (Initial Undergraduate and Alternate Route)*, which was obtained during the 2024–2025 academic year and used to inform Mississippi Valley State University’s CAEP Annual Report submission. Because the Mississippi Impact Report Card operates on a one-year reporting lag, the report reflects outcomes from the prior academic year. However, it represents the most current externally validated and statewide benchmarked dataset available for CAEP Accountability Measures.

Developed to support CAEP Standard 4 (Program Impact), the report provides statewide comparative data on the performance of Mississippi public school students taught by MVSU program completers, including comparisons to statewide teacher averages and statewide Educator Preparation Provider (EPP) averages.

“**Statewide All Teachers**” includes the test data for every student of every teacher in MS public schools.

“**Statewide EPP Total**” includes the test data for students taught by a teacher graduating from the indicated cohort from the 14 EPPs participating in the report.

“**Institution EPP Total**” includes the test data for students taught by a MVSU completer from the indicated cohort.

Mississippi Valley State University’s Traditional Route program saw several promising performance outcomes. Notably:

- A **Grade 5 Science** from the **2021–2022 cohort (2nd-year teacher)** achieved **65.22% Proficient/Advanced**, exceeding both the **Statewide All Teachers average (56.65%)** and the **Statewide EPP average (56.01%)**.
- A **Grade 6 English** from the **2020–2021 cohort (3rd-year teacher)** achieved **45.45% Proficient/Advanced**, exceeding the **Statewide All Teachers average (40.18%)** and the **Statewide EPP average (43.57%)**.
- A **Grade 6 Math** from the **2020–2021 cohort (3rd-year teacher)** achieved **93.18% Proficient/Advanced**, greatly exceeding both the **Statewide All Teachers average (52.49%)** and the **Statewide EPP average (57.35%)**.

Alternate Route MAT completers from MVSU also contributed to significant student gains:

- A **Grade 8 English** from the **2022–2023 cohort (1st-year teacher)** achieved **49.04% Proficient/Advanced**, exceeding both the **Statewide All Teachers average (42.78%)** and the **Statewide EPP average (34.84%)**.
- A **Grade 8 Math** from the **2022–2023 cohort (1st-year teacher)** achieved **56.73% Proficient/Advanced**, slightly exceeding the **Statewide All Teachers average (56.58%)** and surpassing the **Statewide EPP average (47.11%)**.

- A **Grade 5 Math** from the **2021–2022 cohort (2nd-year teacher)** achieved **45.50% Proficient/Advanced**, exceeding the **Statewide EPP average (42.55%)**.
- An **End-of-Course U.S. History** from the **2021–2022 cohort (2nd-year teacher)** achieved **61.70% Proficient/Advanced**, exceeding the **Statewide EPP average (57.85%)**.

While some performance areas indicate opportunities for continued growth, several MVSU completers demonstrated student achievement outcomes that met or exceeded statewide averages. These results reflect MVSU's commitment to preparing educators who positively impact P–12 student learning and support ongoing continuous improvement efforts.
